Our Cookies

Our cookies are "first-party cookies" and can be either permanent or temporary. These essential cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the Site and the provision of specific features and functionalities. While some of these cookies can be manually disabled in your browser, doing so may impact the Site's functionality.

Personalization Cookies

Personalization cookies enable us to recognize repeat visitors to the Site. We use these cookies to record your browsing history, pages visited, and your settings and preferences during each visit to the Site.

Security Cookies

Security cookies play a crucial role in identifying and mitigating security risks. These cookies are used to authenticate users and safeguard user data from unauthorized access.

Site Management Cookies

Site management cookies maintain your identity or session on the Site, preventing unexpected logouts and ensuring that any information you enter is retained from one page to another. These cookies cannot be deactivated individually; however, you can disable all cookies in your browser.

Third-Party Cookies

When you visit the Site, third-party cookies may be placed on your computer by companies providing certain services that we offer. These cookies enable third parties to collect and track specific information about you. You can manually disable these cookies in your browser.

OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

Web beacons and pixel tags cannot be declined; however, you can restrict their use by controlling the cookies that interact with them.
